Why do we "Pass the Peace" during worship? The peace is a transitional point in the service, standing between the proclamation of the word and the sharing of the Lord's supper. In one sense, this greeting sums up the prayers of intercession just concluded: the peace of the risen Christ is the answer to our prayer, God's gift to us all. The people may greet one another in the peace of the risen Christ. The exchange is typically unpatterned, but it is important to hold up its significance as a word from God to one another, rather than as a time for pleasantries. ~ *taken from ELW Leaders Desk Edition*
